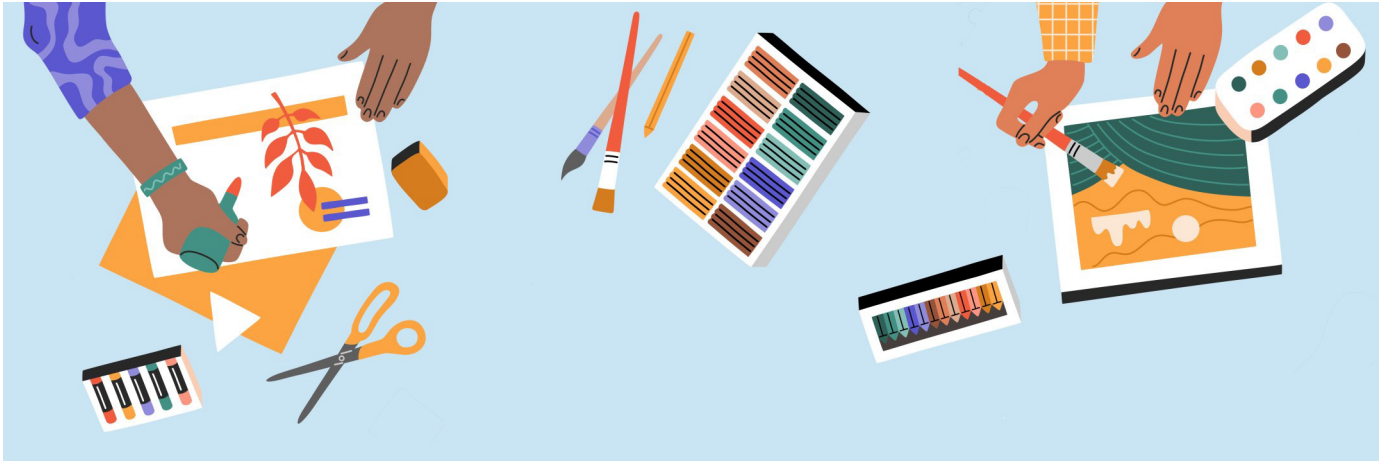




Celebrate Black Voices

2027 Virtual Art Exhibit

We invite you to draw/paint/otherwise depict an individual or historical event featuring Black history or culture. Choose someone or something you find important, inspirational, or fascinating! It can be of a subject you learned in school, read in a book or know from everyday life. Look for interesting and unique subjects to make your artwork stand out. Be creative! Make it your own!

Selected entries will be displayed in a virtual art gallery on Phoenix Public Library's website from February to October 2027 and featured on social media during Black History Month.

The details:

- Artists in **grades K-12** are invited to depict an important person or event celebrating the Black experience in America.
- Each artist may enter one (1) drawing.
- Illustrations can be in any medium: crayon, marker, colored pencil, paint, collage, etc.
- Artwork should be no larger than 11" x 17" on white paper. No lined or colored paper.
- Each submission must be accompanied by a submission form (on the back).
- Entries may be submitted in person at any Phoenix Public Library location or by email to socialmedialibrary@phoenix.gov.
