Growing Instructions

Native Seed Mix

Planting:

- Sow outdoors **Oct–Mar**. Rake soil lightly, scatter seeds, and press gently into the surface. Do **not** bury.

Sun:

- Full sun.

Water:

- Keep moist until germination (7–21 days). After establishment, water deeply every **7–14 days** during dry periods.

Soil:

- Well-draining desert or sandy soil. No fertilizer needed.

Care:

- Thin seedlings to 8–12 inches. Remove weeds early.
Low maintenance and drought- tolerant once established.

Bloom:

- Spring to early summer; some species may reseed naturally.
