Growing Instructions

Yarrow

SOWING:

Transplant (recommended) - Sow into 72-cell flats, or preferred seedling container, 8-10 weeks before planting out. Light is required for germination. Cover seeds with a thin layer of vermiculite to retain moisture and hold seeds in place. Light is required for germination. Bottom water or mist lightly to avoid covering seed. 3-5 weeks at 55-65°F (13-18°C) in full light are ideal conditions for seedling development. Harden off seedlings and transplant outdoors. Direct seed - Late spring, early summer, or fall.

SOIL REQUIREMENTS:

Any well-drained soil.

HARVEST:

When pollen is visible on the flowers. Hang to dry.
