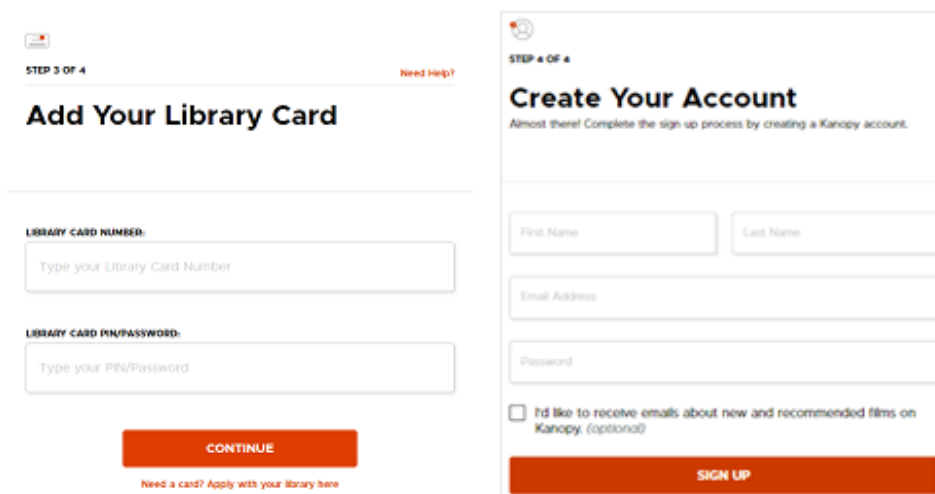


Getting Started with Kanopy

Interested in independent, international, classic, or documentary films? You're in luck.

Get out your library card and sign up for Kanopy, an on-demand video streaming service for libraries.

With Kanopy, you can stream over 30,000 films from hundreds of popular producers such as The Criterion Collection, The Great Courses, and PBS, as well as thousands of independent filmmakers - on every topic imaginable.



Starting from the library's [Kanopy link](#), choose "Add a Library Card." We recommend doing this in a web browser. Add your library card number and the password associated with your library account. This is the same password you use to check out items at the library.

Create a Kanopy account by entering your first and last name, your email address, and a password, then select "Sign up." You choose the password for your Kanopy account. This password should not be the same as your library card password.

After creating your account, you'll receive a verification email in your inbox. Click on the link in this email to verify your email address.
